How about bananas? There are lots of ways to eat bananas. They are great on cereal at breakfast, aren't they? Have you ever eaten banana bread? Yum, yum! One of my favourite snacks is a banana smoothie. Oh, did I mention that bananas have lots of vitamins?

What is one of the best ways to get a lot of vitamin C? The orange, of course!

Where do we get all of these delicious fruits? They come from fruit trees, don't they? Apples come from an apple tree. Oranges come from and orange tree. Bananas come from a banana tree.

Jesus had a lot to say about fruit. He told his followers that they were to bear fruit. Now I don't think he was talking about apples, oranges, and bananas. What do you think Jesus meant when told his followers to bear fruit for him? When Jesus says that good people produce good fruit, he doesn't mean the kind of fruit that we eat. He means that if we are following him, we will want to do the things that make God happy. 




## The Season of Lent

#### Facts about Lent:

- Lent is a time when Christian people get ready for Easter.
- Lent is a sacred time within the Church calendar. It is a time of fasting, prayer and almsgiving.
- Lent lasts for forty days reminding us of the forty days that Jesus spent in the desert doing penance and fasting. It begins on
  - Ash Wednesday (5th March 2025) and finishes before sunset on Holy Thursday. We don't count Sundays in the forty days because Sundays are days of celebration in the Church calendar.
- Purple vestments are worn by the priest during Lent.
- The Gloria and alleluia are not prayed at Mass during Lent.
- · Lent comes for the word "lente" which means springtime.
- Many people promise to do something during Lent to help them to be more like Jesus. Sometimes
  they give up something they like, they fast from sweets, or television. Other people promise to do
  something like being kinder, going to Mass, saying prayers or to put money in the Trócaire box to
  remind them to help others who are not as lucky as they are.
- · What we do during Lent helps us to get ready for Easter.

Ash Wednesday is the First Day of Lent. On Ash Wednesday people are asked to fast. On Ash Wednesday the priest blesses the ashes and uses them to make the sign of the cross on our foreheads. The priest or minister says 'turn away form sin and be faithful to the Gospel', or similar words. Wearing ashes is a sign that a person is going to make an extra special effort during Lent to use his/her gifts for the good of others.

# Time to Think! Prayers for Pope Francis

As I write this article, I am acutely aware that Pope Francis's health is seriously declining. He has led the Catholic Church with integrity, humility, and a deep commitment to living out his faith. His life has been shaped by Jesus Christ, and he has embraced those on the periphery, just as Christ did. Pope Francis is regarded as one of the most significant world leaders, known for his reasoned voice in a turbulent world. Regardless of his current situation, his pontificate will be historically significant.

From the beginning, Francis's papacy surprised many. After Pope Benedict resigned in February 2013, Jorge Mario Bergoglio became the first Jesuit pope, the first pope from the Americas, and the first to take the name Francis. He made immediate changes, opting for a simple lifestyle, living in the Vatican guesthouse instead of the Apostolic Palace and using a Fiat instead of a Mercedes-Benz. His playful rapport with the public signalled a joyful shift in papal leadership.

Pope Francis's actions have consistently defied expectations. He has confessed his sins, embraced the disfigured, visited a migrant camp on Lesbos, and reached out in war-torn countries. He even admitted his mistake in defending a Chilean bishop accused of covering up abuse, demonstrating humility and compassion.

His papacy has also seen significant reforms in the Vatican. He created an advisory council of cardinals, investigated the Vatican Bank, and appointed a woman, Sister Nathalie Becquart, to a key role in the Roman Curia. These changes marked a departure from previous papacies, emphasizing transparency and collaboration.

Pope Francis has also focused outward, addressing the climate crisis in his encyclical Laudato si', traveling to predominantly Muslim countries, and advocating for inclusion, as seen in his compassionate remarks to the LGBT community. His leadership has emphasized mercy and understanding.

His concern for the poor has remained central. He highlights the many forms of poverty—material, spiritual, and moral—and calls for a renewed focus on evangelization and care for the poor. His papacy is revolutionary, not in political terms, but in a return to the Church's roots of passion for the mission and the poor. If Pope Francis resigns or passes away, a conclave will elect his successor. His appointments have been prophetic, creating a College of Cardinals that reflects the universal nature of the Church. During this uncertain time, I pray that the Spirit of God remains close to him. Pope Francis has been a compassionate shepherd, bringing good news to the poor.

May the Lord be near to all who are sick, and may we be inspired by his joy and compassion.


