



Saint Patrick

St. Patrick was born very probably in the early years of the fifth century in Roman colony of Britain. He was taken captive at the age of sixteen and brought to Ireland where he was sold as a slave. He tended herds on Slemish Mountain for six years. His captivity had a very positive effect on his spiritual life. He prayed many times each day, his faith growing



stronger and his love and reverence for God increasing. He escaped back home at the age of twenty-two. It was obvious to him that God was calling him to return to convert the Irish. The voice of the Irish was calling him to come and walk among them once more. He studied probably in France, returned to Ireland as a bishop 457-61, or as early as 432 according to another tradition. His mission was not immediately greatly successful but eventually he would make a tremendous number of converts. Two writings survive: the Letter to Coroticus, a protest to the solders of a British prince who had killed some converts and sold others as slaves, and his Confession written near the end of his life, showing him as one living by the faith he preached and allowing Christ to direct his whole life. He died 491, though again other dates have been suggested, 480 or as early as 461.

Saint Joseph Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary 19th March

It is disappointing considering the importance of St. Joseph's role, that the gospels do not tell us more about him. All we really know of his character is that he was a 'holy and righteous man who generously co-operated with God's grace.' Early Christians must have been more



interested in imitating Joseph's virtues than recording biographical details. So today, as the early Christians did, we honour Joseph for trusting in God's plan even though he had limited understanding of its reasons or consequences. We offer petitions to him as patron saint of fathers, guardians, workers and of the dying.

My Soul is Troubled

Have you ever come across a stone that is small and flat and fits into your hand in such a way that you can rub it with your thumb. Many people carry a stone like this in their pocket. They call it a "worry stone." Whenever they are troubled about something, they just reach into their pocket and rub the worry stone. They believe that rubbing the smooth surface of the stone gives them a peaceful feeling and helps them to quit worrying about their troubles.



If we really want to know what we should do when we face trouble in our life, we should look at what Jesus did.

Just a few days before he was to be crucified, Jesus said, "Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour. Father, glorify your name!" Jesus knew that he was going to die on the cross. He could have asked God to save him. Instead, he only asked that his Father's name would be glorified. Why do troubles come into our life? I believe that troubles come for the very reason that Jesus said - so that God's name will be glorified. I have known people who followed the example of Jesus when they faced trouble in their life. I have even known people who faced death with

ST. PATRICK

As a teenager, Patrick was captured by Irish raiders and forced into slavery for six years. During this time he learned the language and customs of the Irish people. He also grew close to God. After the six years, he escaped and made his way back to his family. Then he decided that the people of Ireland needed him. So, he began to learn the Bible and train for mission work. Once he was ready, he returned to Ireland and preached to the people for 40 years before he died. As he converted the Irish, he made disciples out of them. Many of his followers went on to become renowned religious leaders as well.

Saint Patrick left behind a great example for us to follow. He could have hated the people who stole him from his family, but he knew that they needed God's love. He loved his



St Patrick inspires faith...

true friend.

As I write this article, Taoiseach Micheál Martin is scheduled to meet U.S. President Donald Trump at the White House on March 12, 2025, as part of the traditional St. Patrick's Day celebrations. This meeting continues a long-standing tradition where the Irish Taoiseach visits the U.S. president to mark the occasion, reflecting the deep cultural and economic ties between Ireland and the United States.

The visit was formally confirmed when President Trump invited Martin in a letter, congratulating him on his recent appointment and emphasizing the "special bond" between the two nations. The Taoiseach has expressed his delight at the invitation and looks forward to the meeting, which is expected to include a bilateral discussion in the Oval Office, the presentation of a bowl of shamrock, and other events such as the Speakers' lunch on Capitol Hill.

Key topics anticipated for discussion include U.S. tariffs, which Martin plans to address by highlighting their potential damage to Ireland's small, open economy, as well as the conflicts in Ukraine and Gaza. Martin has emphasized a respectful approach, intending to present Ireland's perspective while acknowledging Trump's views, particularly on achieving peace in Ukraine and consolidating a ceasefire in Gaza. He has also indicated he would "absolutely" invite Trump to visit Ireland, a customary gesture extended to U.S. presidents.

This meeting occurs against a backdrop of global tensions, including Trump's threats of 25% tariffs on EU goods and his recent suspension of military aid to Ukraine, posing diplomatic challenges for Martin. The Taoiseach has stressed the importance of protecting Irish economic interests and maintaining the strong, two-way relationship with the U.S., especially given Ireland's significant trade ties and investments there. I pray that this important diplomatic mission goes well for Ireland.

Saint Patrick's feast day, is now a global event. The Irish diaspora, have contributed significantly to the four corners of the world. In this regard, civic buildings and national monuments will cheerfully be Greened to celebrate our National Holiday. Saint Patrick, was a courageous, faith filled and prophetic voice. His intelligent delivery of Christianity embraced a rich Celtic Spirituality, that celebrated life and seasons, when he walked upon our shore. I pray that this great feast day will continue to offer hope and inspiration. Parishes and villages across the country will gather together and celebrate the great gift of community, volunteerism, sport, music and culture. This indeed is a sacred time and I pray, that this Saint Patrick's weekend will be filled with every blessing for you all.

On St. Patrick's Day we celebrate our Irishness and our faith. For so long in our history they have been intertwined, perhaps at times identified. As a result we may have been tempted to take our faith for granted. Admittedly we did not have to fight for it or die for it as our ancestors did. They were challenged by their faith and responded generously to that challenge.

Today, Irish people all over the world and we here at home rejoice in the new opportunities which are available in our country – for education, employment and a good quality of life. Indeed many of our exiles will tell you that they regret the fact that these opportunities were not available to them before they emigrated. However, a worrying trend, of highly qualified young people, emigrating because of the lack of affordable housing, is a cause of deep concern. In the past the challenge to our faith came from outside of ourselves – from Penal Laws and from oppressive regimes. Today the challenge is not so obvious and it comes from within ourselves. Faith is not something that has myths of compartmentalisation; rather it impinges on all areas of human living. Today there is probably no area of life in which faith is not being challenged and in which it does not have a significant contribution to make.

As individuals and families, whether in our work, socialising, education or whatever, our faith impinges or we can refuse to allow it to do so. At times we misinterpret and misunderstand the nature of faith. Great faith is not a faith that walks in the light and knows no darkness. Real faith perseveres inspite of God's seeming silence.

When one considers the obstacles with which Patrick contended taken captive from his own people and his home, slavery on Slieve Mish, eventual escape and yet prepared to return as a missionary and preach Christ's gospel to those who had held him captive.

The wholeheartedness and single mindedness of Patrick are clear pointers to his faith. He is a man of flesh and blood whose whole life was fed on faith in God's love. Faith must have been a struggle for him, as it is for you and me. In the experience of slavery it must have been tempting for him to abandon faith and yield to despair. Yet he recognised his real helplessness and turned to God as a helper and a

Slavery in the 21st century takes on a more sinister and subtle form. Work, pleasure, comfort, the celebrity status.

Almost unnoticed God can be excluded and pushed out to the margins of life in a busy competitive world. With so many voices clambering for our attention we have to make and effort to keep the lines of communication open with God in prayer and in our participation at Mass and the sacraments.

In a confused and complex culture we need a compass to provide us with a sense of direction. Enabling us to cope with and respond to the various challenges which meet us every day. I am convinced that faith, properly understood and genuinely lived can provide us with such a compass. Faith can enable us to see beneath and beyond the situations in which we find ourselves. Just as in Patrick's life, faith made it possible for God to enter, so in our lives faith makes it possible for God to become involved in our busy world and our hectic activity. As we celebrate St. Patrick's Day I take this opportunity to wish you a very happy celebration and pray that the faith that Patrick brought to our shores will sustain all of us in challenging times.

If St. Patrick were looking at the 6:1 News this evening, he would undoubtedly be surprised to find that his name was associated with the greening of the Great Wall of China and of the Pyramids in Egypt. The marketing people have been very clever in turning our national feast day into an opportunity to promote tourism and to seek opportunities for overseas trade. Fair play to them. If these things help to strengthen our economy and to ensure that all our people can live with dignity and enjoy the fruits of citizenship, then there is nothing wrong with that. But we who believe in Jesus need to be doing a bit of marketing ourselves. St. Paul reminds us that the time will come when many people will not want to hear the message of the Gospel. The image of the weeds and the wheat growing together is a common theme in the Gospels, it is a reminder that faith and unbelief exist side by side in our society. It is not the responsibility of politicians, economists or entrepreneurs as such to promote faith. It is our task as Christians, together with Christians of other religious traditions throughout Ireland, to ensure that the primary focus of St. Patrick's Day remains the reception of the Gospel and that the values of the Gospel permeate our civil society

St. Patrick's Breastplate is a popular prayer attributed to one of Ireland's most beloved patron saints. According to tradition, St. Patrick wrote it in 433 A.D. for divine protection before successfully converting the Irish King Leoghaire and his subjects from paganism to Christianity. (The term breastplate refers to a piece of armour worn in battle.)




